The Right Rev. Michael K. Skrocki was born in Allentown, PA in September of 1964. He grew up in the Allentown area and attended Catholic grade school and high school. Fr. Michael was appointed Pastor of St. Ann Melkite Greek-Catholic Church, Danbury Connecticut in 2004 and in 2007, he completed his doctorate in Canon Law at The Catholic University of America.

Fr. Michael serves on the Eparchial Seminary Board, the Eparchial Presbyteral Council, the College of Eparchial Consultors and teaches Canon Law at the Eparchial Deacon Training Program. He has also edited almost thirty volumes of liturgical material for Sophia Press - the publishing wing of the Eparchy - many of these works appearing for the first time in complete, modern-English translations. Currently, Fr. Michael serves as Adjutant Judicial Vicar for the Eparchy as well as a Tribunal Judge for the Ruthenian Archeparchy of Pittsburgh and an Appellate Court Judge for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Bridgeport.
