Two Saturday's ago Alicia Patchoski after D. Liturgy told me that she would not be able to act as chairman anymore for the Food Festival.

The following is an email I wrote to her:

"Just wanted to come back to our talk last Saturday.... topics got changed too quickly and I was a bit surprised from your news... which is to say... I did not have the wherewithal to speak what was on my mind at the time.

"Most importantly, thank you for the all the years of service you rendered to St. Joseph Church with regard to the Food Festival. It was so transparent to me -and I think others - that you took on the responsibility and labored so strenuously (even when family matters and parish troubles weighed upon you) because of a genuine love for God and our small parish, frail as we are. You did the work very well and made it prosper in so many ways.

"Your decision, no doubt, was difficult to make. When you told me about it (it was not quite what I was expecting at the moment); it rung true to me and I was at peace. Though at peace, also sad to have your talent lost in that capacity. I think everyone will agree: after our duties to Almighty God, family comes first. And it is very difficult to raise a Christian family today.

"I can speak on behalf of all the parishioners that we are proud of your work, your achievements and your dedication; and we are grateful for your bearing more than your share of the burden these years."
